

## Notification of HEERF Grant

Students interested in applying should visit <https://form.jotform.com/202785779433064> to complete the application. The grant can be used to help students with food, housing, course materials, technology, health care and childcare.

To be eligible, the applicant must meet all the following requirements:

1. Be a currently enrolled student at The Salon Professional Academy of Kenosha
2. Have been enrolled in an on-campus certificate program prior to March 13, 2020
3. Be eligible or could be eligible for federal financial aid
4. Have a High School Diploma or GED
5. Must be making Satisfactory Academic Progress
6. Be a U.S. Citizen or eligible noncitizen
7. Complete this online HEERF Grant application
8. Have supportive and verifiable documentation of negative financial impact of COVID-19
9. Be available and respond to the SSA Administration when they reach out
10. Have not previously received a HEERF Grant

All grant applications will be reviewed by the Financial Aid Office and may require additional criteria be met. Students will be notified on the status of their application via their email address and will be contacted through email and phone if additional information is needed. Students who qualify for grant funds will have the money disbursed to their email on file at the academy with and attached echeck within 14 days of receiving an approval email.

### Acknowledgement of Funds

The Salon Professional Academy of Kenosha has signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement to receive the Student and Institutional Portion of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund. The institution further acknowledges that it will use no less than fifty percent of the funds received under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to its students.

### Instructions to Students

At The Salon Professional Academy of Kenosha, \$149,246 has been allocated to the academy. \$74,623 of the previously mentioned amount has been allocated to assist students through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund. The academy will have an application process to facilitate the distribution of funds. Applications will be considered and approved based on documented need and expenses due to COVID-19. Students who are approved will receive a grant equal to \$2,000.

### Application

Students seeking consideration for assistance from the HEERF are advised to complete the HEERF application found on our website. Students who apply must attest, under penalty of the law, that the expenses detailed in the application are true and accurate and be able to produce documentation of expenses incurred. The application will be available through December 31, 2020. Notification of awards will be sent 7-14 business days after the approval of a submitted application and funds will be emailed with an attached echeck to the student no later than 14 business days from the date their application is approved.
